It's the kind of asset that creates a community not just a location, and one that would be the envy of many a town across the UK. I am sure it will be even more appreciated once the current Covid-19 closure has passed and will thrive for years to come; its loss to the town is unthinkable and would be to the detriment to the arts, heritage, culture, diversity, mental health and most of all quality of life of the community.
